

# PRIVACY POLICY

## COMMITMENT TO PRIVACY

Brisbane Christian Fellowship (BCF) was established as a local church during the 1970s, and now has a large congregation that meets in the Samford Valley, on Brisbane's north-west. BCF is a vibrant fellowship of individuals and families, who live, work and relate in the local community and gather together every Sunday for a communion service.

BCF is an association incorporated under the *Associations Incorporation Act 1981* (Qld) located at 40 Burton Lane, Samford, Queensland, Australia.

The objects of BCF are as follows:

- (a) The encouragement, propagation and development of the religious beliefs of the association and in particular the object of the association shall be the propagation of the Gospel as commanded:

"Go ye therefore and teach all nations, baptising them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost, teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world". Matthew 28:19-20.

- (b) To educate people in a knowledge and understanding of the Bible and of biblical principles, as well as in communication, interpersonal skills and life skills, by systematic training and instruction so that they will be equipped for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up. Ephesians 4:12.

- (c) The support, protection, and assistance of incorporated and unincorporated associations, companies or other entities, whose objects are altogether or in part similar to those of the association; in particular, the association may provide administrative, legal or financial advice or support to affiliated entities throughout the world.

BCF respects the privacy of individuals when collecting and handling personal information and is committed to adopting the highest standards to safeguard the personal information of individuals. BCF is bound by and complies with the National Privacy Principles, contained within the *Privacy Act 1988* (Commonwealth) (the Act).

The collection, use and disclosure of personal information by BCF is regulated as follows:

## PERSONAL INFORMATION

Personal information is information or an opinion, whether true or not, and whether recorded in a material form or not, about an individual whose identity is apparent, or can be reasonably ascertained, from that information or opinion.

## SENSITIVE INFORMATION

Sensitive information is a subset of 'personal information' that is information specifically about an individual's racial or ethnic origin, political opinions, membership of a political association, religious beliefs or affiliations, philosophical beliefs, membership of a professional or trade association or trade union, sexual preferences or practices or criminal record.

BCF is committed to protecting sensitive personal information, which may be collected to carry out its functions or activities.

## COLLECTION OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

BCF only collects personal information necessary to carry out its functions or activities. The following are an example of the functions and activities carried out by BCF:

- employment of staff including Ministers of Religion
- receiving prayer requests for various needs and actioning the same in public meetings
- organising events held at the church such as weddings or working bees
- running training programmes such as bible studies
- facilitating various age-specific programmes such as Seniors, Young Adults, Teenagers and Son Seekers
- rostering volunteer service teams (for example to clean the church or use of musical instruments during the worship service)
- communicating to BCF members to provide information on upcoming events.

BCF collects personal information directly from the congregation when it is provided to the church office or via the Lampstand website (<http://lampstand.bcf.org.au>).

## USE AND DISCLOSURE OF PERSONAL AND SENSITIVE INFORMATION

BCF uses or discloses personal information it collects in accordance with its functions and activities and in compliance with the Act.

BCF will not disclose personal information about an individual for a purpose other than the primary purpose of collection. BCF will only disclose personal information if that purpose is directly related to the reason it was first collected.

## CORRESPONDENCE

BCF may use the details supplied by an individual in order to provide details of church-related matters or regarding upcoming events at BCF. Where BCF receives a request from an individual with respect to the individual's privacy options, including an unsubscribe request, BCF will use all reasonable efforts to delete the relevant personal information from its records, however, BCF cannot guarantee that the information will be deleted as there is a possibility that a residual copy of the information will be maintained on a back-up system.

## QUALITY AND SECURITY OF YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

Personal information held by BCF is protected from misuse, loss, unauthorised access, modification or disclosure by a range of security measures including computer network security systems, restricted access and building security systems, firewalls, expert computer monitoring and passwords for checking identity before disclosing information. Any information submitted via the Lampstand website uses standard technology to ensure all personal information is kept private. Information on the Lampstand website is protected by encryption and firewall technology. Only authorised employees and volunteers are permitted to access an individual's personal information. BCF employees and volunteers must comply with the Privacy Policy of BCF.

Personal Information provided during church-organised events or programmes are collected by BCF employees and volunteers and stored in the BCF office with restricted access. BCF will take reasonable steps to implement and maintain security precautions and endeavour to prevent unauthorised access to, disclosure or use of submitted information.

An individual's e-mail address and password enable BCF to verify the individual's identity and to help BCF to ensure that personal information of an individual is kept secure. Each individual issued login access to Lampstand is responsible for maintaining the secrecy of their login details.

Each individual using Lampstand should sign out or close the browser once they have completed their session within Lampstand to ensure others cannot access an individual's personal information.

## ACCESS AND CORRECTION OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

If an individual wishes to update their personal information held by BCF, changes can be made through the Lampstand website or directly through the BCF office. Individuals can login and click on the 'My Details' link. This will provide access to an individual's personal information unless BCF deems it necessary to refuse access to that information in conformity with the Act. If BCF denies a request for access to personal information, then BCF will, on request, provide reasons for that denial.

## COOKIES

A cookie is a small text file created by a web server and stored on a computer, enabling a unique identification to be given to that computer. Cookies enable systems to track an individual's clicks as they browse and move between pages on a website. BCF does not use cookies to retrieve or store personal information about an individual from their computer. Most Internet browsers are pre-set to accept cookies. If an individual prefers not to receive cookies, they can adjust their Internet browser to disable or to warn the individual when cookies are used.

## SITE LOGS

Our service provider records your visit to our web site and logs information from your browser including your IP address, the date and time of your visit, the pages accessed, documents downloaded, and the type of browser used. This is a fraud prevention measure, and enables us to evaluate our website usage and improve our online service. This information is not linked back to individual users except in the unlikely event of an investigation, where a law enforcement agency may exercise a warrant to inspect the service provider's logs.

## LINKS TO OTHER SITES

The BCF website may contain links to the websites of entities affiliated with BCF, however, BCF is not responsible for the privacy practices or content of such websites.

## CHANGES TO PRIVACY POLICY

BCF's information practices and Privacy Policy will be monitored and periodically updated in conformity with the Act. BCF will notify you of any amendments to its Privacy Policy by posting an updated version on its lampstand site.
